2012-2013 , he was a full time coach at the Academy of Omiya Ardija (J-league, Japan). In 2014, he assumed the position of Head coach at the Development centre of Arsenal franchise in Japan (Ichikawa)

Head Coach Robbie is currently taking charge of the NFA U-14 Team that trains at the Singapore Sports School.

He was also the assistant coach of J.League Division 2 club Brummel Sendai (currently known as Vegalta Sendai) in 1996, having also taken charge of the club's U15 side.
